
Here is some information we would like to share to make your time more enjoyable...

About the auto detergent

If you have forgotten to bring detergent, no worries! Use the auto detergent that is included with your wash. Our detergent is locally made by Bendigo Bill from a blend of anionic and non-anionic surfactants. It is biodegradable, grey water safe and contains pure eucalyptus oil.

How to use your own detergent

If you prefer to use your own detergent, that's fine too. Just switch the setting to **manual detergent** with the grey dial when you are choosing your water temperature. You can add your own to the top of the machine; just follow this guide:



Starting the machines

Payment doesn't start the machines; you need to be sure to **push the GREY start button** on washers and dryers to get things going.

IS THE WASHING MACHINE SHOWING AN ERROR MESSAGE? DID YOU PUSH THE RED BUTTON?

Whoops! The red button is an emergency stop button, NOT a start button! If this causes an ERROR message, you can release it. Just turn the red button to the left and then push the grey start button twice to get the cycle going again.

Check you've got everything

Please be sure to check washers and dryers before you leave to make sure you have everything. We have a lost and found basket; please ask us if you are missing something. Unclaimed items will be disposed of after 30 days.

Can't see the dryers?

We have six dryers up the back, opposite the lockers. Just look for the 'DRY' sign.

Troubleshooting: machine leak

If a machine is leaking water it is most likely because it has been loaded incorrectly and the door cannot seal properly.

- Please **STOP THE MACHINE** using the red button.
- Open the door and make sure there are no items blocking the seal.
- Close and lock the door.
- Twist the red button to the left to release and restart the machine.
- You can use the rags provided in the box under the folding table if you would like to mop up. Kindly text 0460 309 776 to report the incident.
